Pieced Cotton Applique Wool Applique Mixed Media Techniques

Hand Quilted Quilts Small (60” and under)

Pieced Cotton Applique Wool Applique Mixed Media Techniques

Miniature (24” and under with maximum finished block size 4”)

Junior (age 18 and under) (anything goes)

****Note:** Mixed Media Techniques is a term used to describe artwork composed of a combination of different media or materials. In quilting, it is most often seen in Art Quilts and Collage work.

THIS WILL BE A JURIED SHOW WITH THE FOLLOWING CONTEST RULES:

- 1. Please keep a copy of your original entry form to be submitted with your quilt if selected.**
- 2. Include two (2) photos** with the entry form for judging or exhibiting only
 - One (1) full view photo which must include all finished edges
 - One (1) detail view photo
 - Do not photograph yourself with the item; it must be pictured alone.
 - Staple the photos in the upper left-handed corner if you are not submitting electronically.
 - If not electronically, photos should be no larger than 4" x 6"
- 3. Use one form for each item submitted. Complete ALL sections.**
Incomplete entry forms will not be considered.
- 4. All quilts must be quilted through 3 layers by hand or machine or both. Quilts in hard frames and tied quilts will not be accepted.**
- 5. Quilts must be clean and in show condition. (No animal hair or odor.)**
- 6. All quilts must be permanently identified on the back. A 4-inch sleeve is required on every quilt for hanging.**
- 7. You must determine the category in which your submission will be entered.**
- 8. Quilts may only be entered in one category.**
- 9. All quilts need to be folded.**
- 10. All quilts must have been made within the last five years.**
- 11. All decisions by the jury and judges are final. The jury reserves the right to reject or reclassify any entry.**
- 12. Each entry requires a separate entry form and \$10 non-refundable entry fee. Payable with Pay Pal. Or if not electronically submitted -- Make checks payable to the Elkhart County Quilt & Fiber Expo. Cash not accepted.**
- 13. No more than two (2) entries per category and no more than three (3) total entries will be accepted from any one (1) person.**
- 14. Notification of acceptance by Jury will be on or about May 5, 2023 via email including instructions and address for submission.**
- 15. Quilts selected by the jury will be displayed at the Elkhart County Quilt & Fiber Expo in the RV/MH Hall of Fame June 8-10, 2023.**
